

# A Guide To Reasonable Eats Around Phuket



**Anton's Restaurant**  
Soi Sawatdeeruk, Patong

A large restaurant situated 50 mtrs from the beach road. Their Sunday Roast at 290 baht gives you roast beef, pork and lamb with fresh vegetables and a glass of wine or draught beer.

**Most Expensive** - Fillet Salmon with mustard sauce 300 baht:  
**Most Popular** - Pizzas 160 - 180 baht



**Clarets Lounge**  
68 Nanai Road Patong

A popular establishment with local expats. The food is simple but sufficient with an extensive Thai and Western menu. Big on the breakfast and lunch trade.

**Most Expensive** - Australian Steak - 250 baht:  
**Most Popular** - Beef Stew - 100 baht



**Crossroads Guesthouse Restaurant**  
Soi Wattana, Patong

Two minutes from the beach in Soi Wattana (see map page 30) Chef prepared dishes. The top priced dish on this menu contains mouth watering Tiger Prawns, Snapper and Crab.

**Most Expensive** - BBQ Seafood - 580 baht:  
**Most Popular** - Fillet Mignon - 270 baht



**Pickles**  
Off Beach Rd Patong

Average price around 250 baht. The full SA BBQ is more than a mouthful with Beef or Pork fillet, Lamb or pork chop, a Beef kebab, a Pork kebab, spare ribs and a sausage, all topped off with baked potato and salad

**Most Expensive** - Full South African BBQ - 500 baht:  
**Most Popular** - Marinated Ribs with French Fries - 180 baht



**Palm Tree Restaurant**  
Nanai Road, Patong

A recent joint winner of our Best Breakfast Award, the presentation doesn't stop there. The Curry Massaman never fails to impress and they have a special running for July where the menu is 99 baht or less (except steak which is 20% off).

**Most Expensive** - Imported Sirloin Steak - 310 baht:  
**Most Popular** - Cottage Pie - 150 baht



**Panorama Restaurant**  
Hasip Pee Road, Patong

The magnificent views offered from the restaurant at the Hilltop Hotel is more than matched by the innovative and delicious food. The dishes offered are a fusion between Thai and Western cuisine.

**Most Expensive** - T-Bone Steak - 480 baht:  
**Most Popular** - Cordon Bleu Pork - 280 baht



**Heroes Grill**  
Soi Sawtdeeruk Road, Patong

Hearty English fare is offered here. Their Sunday Roast is meant to fill you up and does just that. At 180 baht it has to be one of the best deals in Patong.

**Most Expensive** - T-Bone Steak - 350 baht:  
**Most Popular** - Pork Chop - 170 baht



**Tavern on the Hill**  
21 Hasip Pee Road, Patong

Chef prepared dishes. The other joint winner of the Best Breakfast award. Quiet setting halfway up the hill behind Patong. Their Bagels are very popular, check out the Smoked Salmon.

**Most Expensive** - Ribeye Steak - 425 baht:  
**Most Popular** - Steak & Kidney Pie - 150 baht



**Two Black Sheep**  
172 Rat-U-Thit 200 Pee Rd Patong

A short walk north of Bangla Rd, this place offers generous portions on all meals. Two separate kitchens - one for Thai food and the other for Western food so the odours don't mix. Hamburgers (NZ beef) 140 baht: Usually busy.

**Most Expensive** - NZ Surloin Steak - 380 baht:  
**Most Popular** - Lamb Shanks - 340 baht
