**Angus O'Tool's Irish Pub, Restaurant & Guesthouse**  
 516/20 Patak Road, Karon (opposite Islandia Hotel)  
 Try the Big Bhoyo breakfast, served all day. Specials every day including Monday's Mick's Grill, Tuesday's authentic Brummie Balti night, Thursday's Home Made Pies and Friday's all-you-can-eat BBQ. Try the large Roast Dinners every Sunday.  
 Cheapest draft Guinness and Kilkenny on the island.  
**Most Expensive** - Lamb Shank - 340 Baht  
**Most Popular** - Irish Stew / Guinness Beef - 200 Baht



**Palm Tree Restaurant**  
 Nanai Road, Patong  
 A recent menu revamp sees a mixed flambe of beef, chicken and sausage done in brandy for 190 baht as a tasty dish for this month. Great ambience with a pool for those warm days.

**Two Black Sheep**  
 172 Rat-U-Thit 200 Pee Rd Patong  
 A short walk north of Bangla Rd, this place offers generous portions on all meals. Two separate kitchens. Friday nights features an All-You-Can-Eat Oyster night for 150 Baht Hamburgers (NZ beef) 140 baht: Usually busy.  
**Most Expensive** - NZ Surloin Steak - 380 Baht  
**Most Popular** - Lamb Shanks - 340 Baht



**Pickles Pub & Bistro**  
 Off Beach Rd Patong  
 Average price around 250 baht. The full SA BBQ is more than a mouthful with Beef or Pork fillet, Lamb or pork chop, a Beef kebab, a Pork kebab, spare ribs and a sausage, all topped off with baked potato and salad  
**Most Expensive** - Full South African BBQ - 500 Baht  
**Most Popular** - Marinated Ribs with French Fries - 240 Baht



**Tavern on the Hill**  
 21 Hasip Pee Road, Patong  
 Chef prepared dishes. The other joint winner of the Best Breakfasts award. Quiet setting halfway up the hill behind Patong. Their Bagels are very popular, check out the Smoked Salmon.

**Most Popular** - Steak & Kidney Pie - 150 Baht



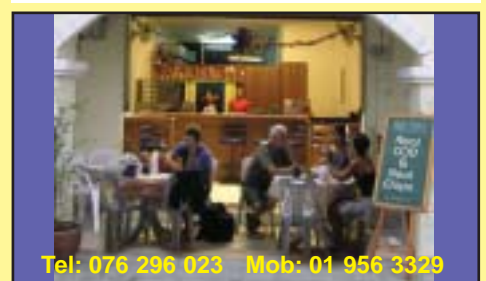
**Dog & Duck**
