THAI PASSPORTS

The renewal or replacement of Thai Passports is the responsibility of the Royal Thai Embassy, Canberra (Tel 02 6273 1149, Fax 02 6273 1518). Copies of passport renewal forms may be collected from the Royal Thai Consulate, Perth, but on completion should be sent to the Embassy by the passport holder.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

Members of the public who intend visiting Thailand for any purpose other than tourism require a Non-Immigrant Visa irrespective of length of stay. This visa is required for the following purposes; - business visits, business enquiries, work in Thailand, attending all types of conferences, seminars, cultural and sporting events. Visitors who are combining any of these activities with holidays will require a visa.

Visas must be obtained before arriving in Thailand.

Holders of passports (not Certificates of Identity) of the countries listed below - may enter Thailand and stay for a period of thirty (30) days for Tourist purposes only, without a visa, provided they are in possession of a confirmed return or onward ticket before they enter Thailand:

Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brazil, Bahrain, Brunei, Canada, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Korea, Kuwait, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Peru, Philippines, Portugal, Saudi Arabia, Qatar, Singapore, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, United Arab Emirates, UK, USA, and Vietnam.

Visitors from the above countries who intend to stay in excess of thirty (30) days require a Tourist Visa.

Visitors from all other countries who are visiting Thailand require a visa irrespective of length of stay.

VISA FEES

Tourist Visa: AUD \$45.00

Non-Immigrant Visa: \$90.00 per entry or \$225.00 for a Multiple Entry Visa, which will enable unlimited entries in the following 12 months.
