International

Angus O'Tool's - *Opposite Islandia Park Resort, Karon*
Nicely presented superb food. The chef used to run the Beefeater around the corner which was regarded as one of the best restaurants on the island.

Montes - *Phisitkorrane Rd. cnr Hasip Pee Patong*
Only opened a few of months ago but we keep getting good reports about the food.

Black Cat - *Cherng Talay*
Run by the affable Philippe, very popular with the Laguna locals. Half way between the Cherng Talay lights and the Laguna turnoff. Always busy in the evenings.

Tavern on the Hill - *21 Hasipee Rd Patong*
Be it breakfast, lunch or an evening meal you really can't go wrong here. Their Thai menu would also rank in the Top 5 for Thai restaurants as well.

Tipsy Prawn - *Thawewong Rd. Patong*
It has just relocated to the beach side in the Sandy House arcade. Everyone who has had a meal there has raved about the place and you can't get a better recommendation than that.

Geo Guesthouse - *Soi Sansabai Patong*
250 Baht Sunday Roast All-U-Can-Eat that is also held on Wednesday.

Legends Bar - *Soi Chalermprakit (Eden) Patong*
100 Baht BBQ Wednesday & Saturday All-U-Can-Eat 7:30pm

Nok & Chicken - *Sky Inn Complex, Patong*
75 Baht breakfast or 115 for full English brekky

TOP 5 - Places to Chill Out

Friendship Beach - Chalong

Between Chalong and Rawai, this place is perfect for an afternoon. It has plenty of room and a pool you can use if you use their bar or restaurant services. Perched right on the waters edge, you can gaze at the islands in the bay or watch the horses trot past from the nearby riding school.

Paradise Beach - Patong
