Phone Number Changes

10 Digits Start NOW

Thailand will change from 9-digit to 10-digit **mobile** telephone system on September 1.

According to the National Telecommunications Commission (NTC) the 10-digit system will provide the country with enough mobile telephone numbers for the next 30 years.

Beginning September 1, users of all mobile telephone systems will have to dial the prefix 08. For example; The number 01-123-4567 will be changed to 08-112-345-67 and the new number of 09-123-4567 will be 08-912-345-67.

The last time an extra number was added was in July 2001
