A ten-year project has commenced to improve the cultural and artistic environment in Phuket and open up possibilities for the area to develop its self-active arts and culture.

Called Platr (Phuket life access tracking) it will consist of artist-in-residence programs, events and workshops, and art education.

Conceived and funded from Japan and supported locally by The Art Center, Chulalongkorn University and Phuket's Rajabhat University and Prince of Songkla University the project will invite 1 or 2

artists to Phuket each month.

They'll stay in Phuket for 10 to 14 days. Artists to be invited are mainly those who are young and just starting their career, but who'll already have some interesting works or vision and are expected to become successful.

The project will evolve in the area centered in southern Phuket around Patong and Phuket Town.
