



TOP 5 - Places to Eat International

Angus O'Tool's - *Opposite Islandia Park Resort, Karon*
Nicely presented superb food. They have different specials on every day so the menu never gets tiring.

Montes - *Phisitkorrane Rd. cnr Hasip Pee Patong*
This place has a good reputation for quality food. Reasonably priced and well presented.

Shakers - *Rat-U-Thit 200 Pee Rd. opposite the Patong Merlin Resort.*
A very busy restaurant. Their presentation and decent sized meals are to be commended. One of the better burgers around. Friendly staff.

Tavern on the Hill - *21 Hasipee Rd Patong*
Be it breakfast, lunch or an evening meal you really can't go wrong here.

Tipsy Prawn - *Thaweewong Rd. Patong*
It has just relocated to the beach side in the Sandy House arcade. Everyone who has had a meal there has raved about the place and you can't get a better recommendation than that.

TOP Value Plus Deals

Coffee Pot - *Patak Rd., Kata*
Have to be one of the best burgers on the island - 180 baht with cheese, huge self-baked bun. Their steak dinners after 6pm are also getting rave reviews.

Sheila's Guesthouse - *Soi Sansabai Patong*
300 Baht Sunday Roast, also held on Wednesday.

Nok & Chicken - *Sky Inn Complex, Patong*
100 baht All-U-Can-Eat English breakfast. Opens 8am

Swiss Inn - *Sawadeerak Rd., Patong*
410 Baht Buffet every Friday night. All-U-Can-Eat The prawns alone cover the cost. From 7:30pm

Royal Phuket City Hotel - *Phang Nga Rd., Phuket City*
An All-U-Can-Eat buffet lunch everyday for 299 Baht at the restaurant on the 19th floor.

TOP Places to Chill Out

Friendship Beach - Chalong

Between Chalong and Rawai, this place is perfect for an afternoon. It has plenty of room and a pool you can use if you use their bar or restaurant services. Perched right on the waters edge, you can gaze at the islands in the bay or watch the horses trot past from the nearby riding school.

Paradise Beach - Patong

A quiet little family run bay at the south end of Patong bay. It is now accessible by car or bike and despite their 10% service charge on everything is still a great place to get away from it all.

Surin Beach - Surin

Our pick for watching the sunset. Sit at Divers bar overlooking the beach and you'll end up running into half of the Surin locals doing the same thing.

Nikita's - Beachfront Rawai

Just as you turn to the Rawai beachfront coming from Chalong is Nikita's. A top spot for a sundowner. Very popular.

Small View / After Beach - Kata

These two located next door to each other are on the hill behind Kata Noi and have reggae music wafting through the air as you balance precariously on the hillside.

Kathu Waterfall - Kathu

The largest cascade on the island. Take the turn before the Loch Palm Golf Course turnoff in Kathu. Quiet and peaceful and if it does get a little warm you can always dip your toes in the numerous waterholes that follow the cascade down the hillside.

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
