The menu lists Salmon, Pork and Swordfish steaks as well as beef, which should keep most tastes happy. One comment I will make is the bread supplied, while not stale didn't taste as fresh as it could have. I'm sure this was just an oversight and didn't detract from meal or ambience of the place in any

way, but Phuket, after being in a bakery wasteland for as long as I can remember has a few skilled bakers arriving on our shores and there are some excellent breads available.

You can expect a friendly atmosphere and an excellent meal here and if that quality is maintained, I don't think it will be too long before you will see The Steak House full every night.
