

SUDOKU



The aim of the games below is to use the numbers 1 through 9 only once in any line across or down and only once in each of the 3 x 3 squares.

For example; The top left 3 x 3 square in the Easy game has five numbers; 1, 4, 5, 6 and 9, already filled in leaving 2, 3, 7, and 8 to fill the remaining squares.

It is a simple game of logic where the degree of difficulty is determined by the amount and position of numbers given

We now have Four levels to choose from. Good Luck.

No answers are given as there is only one solution (no guesswork) and you will know if you have it right.
