Our first thoughts when we received this was .. Where?

The office of the Andaman Post would be less than 100 metres from this restaurant, but we never even knew it existed. When we wandered up the little Soi towards the hill behind Patong off Nanai Road, we were greeted with a wide-open expanse of manicured lawns and bungalows dotted around at the base of the hill. It is here that you see a brightly coloured sign pointing to the Palm Tree Restaurant.

The restaurant is situated on the ground floor of a block of residential apartments.

We spent a pleasant afternoon sitting by the pool being

pampered by the friendly staff. The restaurant has an extensive menu of quality European and Thai food. Being a French English collaboration (unusual we know, but it works) many of the European dishes are prepared differently according to the nationality of the diners.

The menu consists of many homemade dishes like beef cooked in beer, cottage pie, lasagne and juicy steaks with homemade fries (probably the best in Phuket), complimented by a wide choice of Thai cuisine all at reasonable prices.

The whole layout has an air of casual elegance to it and being elevated gives the impression that you are well above it all. Be sure to take them up on their special offer on **all drinks during September at 60 baht.** (Excluding Bacardi Breezers).
