Kruisin' In Krabi

Having never been to Krabi, I took the opportunity to visit when some friends arrived in Phuket from Australia. They said they wanted to see as much of the area during their brief stay, so off we went. With mountains virtually dropping straight into the sea, Krabi is a spectacular place to visit.

Looking for accommodation for future visits we came across the Krabi Sands Resort, a 26-room bungalow style layout right on the beach at Nong Talay. It is just a few hundred metres up the beach from the Sheraton and only a fraction of the cost.

Mark Chapman and his wife, Oay, have built this place from scratch and three years later, the last bit of lawn is being put in place. Both Mark and Oay have extensive backgrounds in the hotel and catering industry and knew exactly what they wanted even before the plans were drawn

up. The result is a visually exquisite and comfortable setting to really get away from it all.

The restaurant on the beach is the perfect

Christmas - New Year period.

Coupled with the stunning scenery so close at hand, and no jet skis destroying the calm, this idyllic little hideaway wins our pick as
